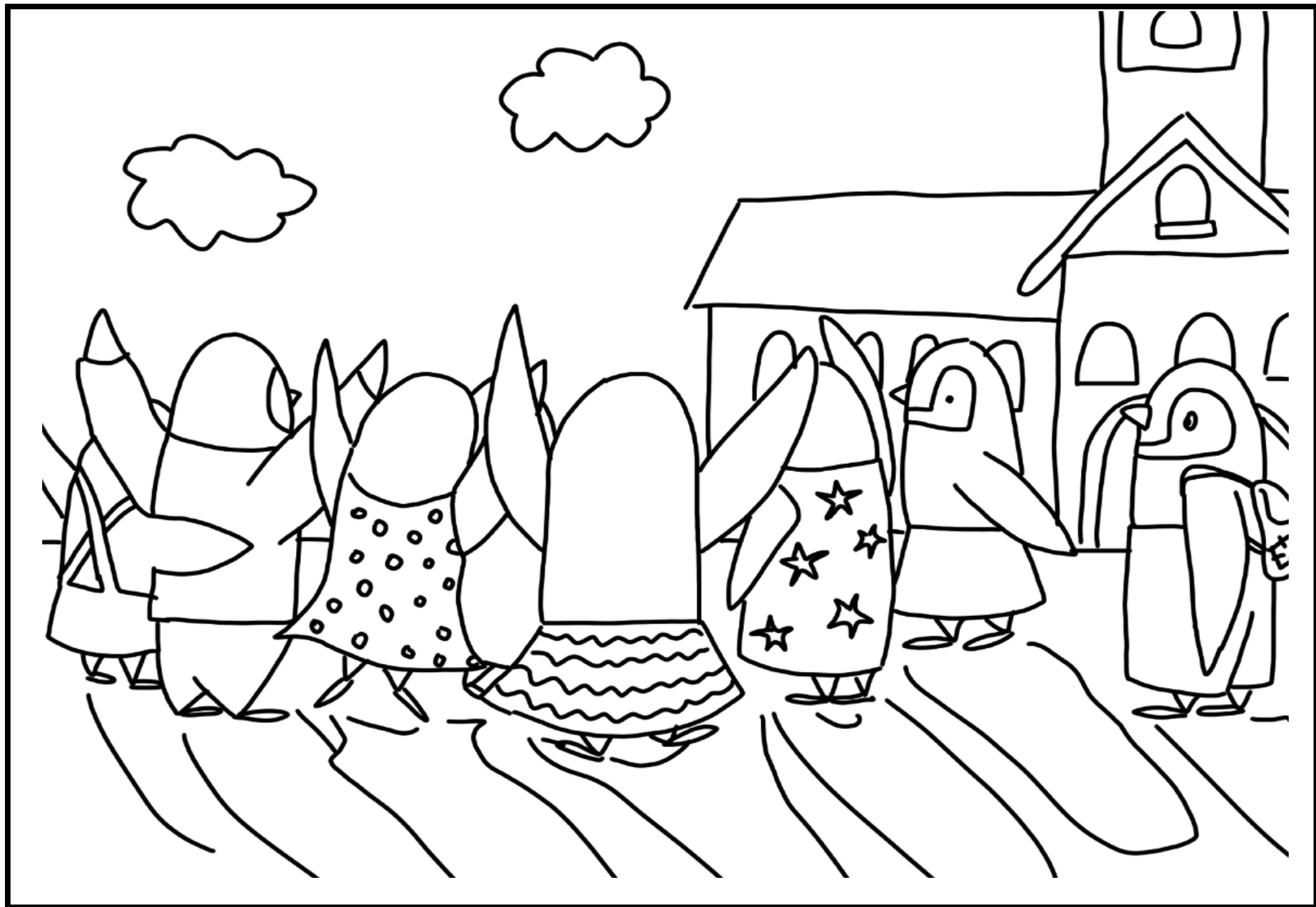

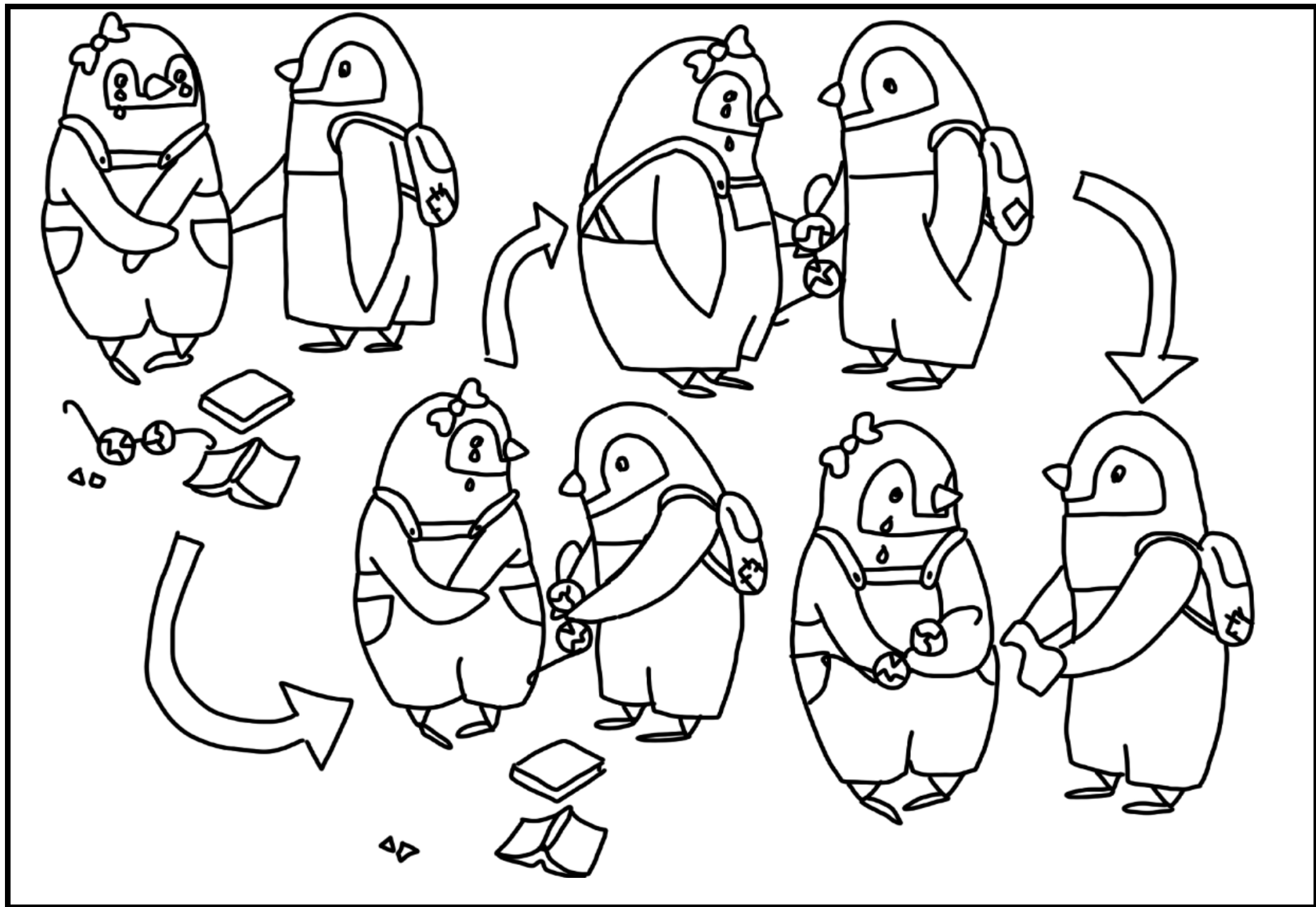
All the other penguins are playing together and Sergio is left all alone. How do you think he is feeling? Colour the sky to match his emotions.



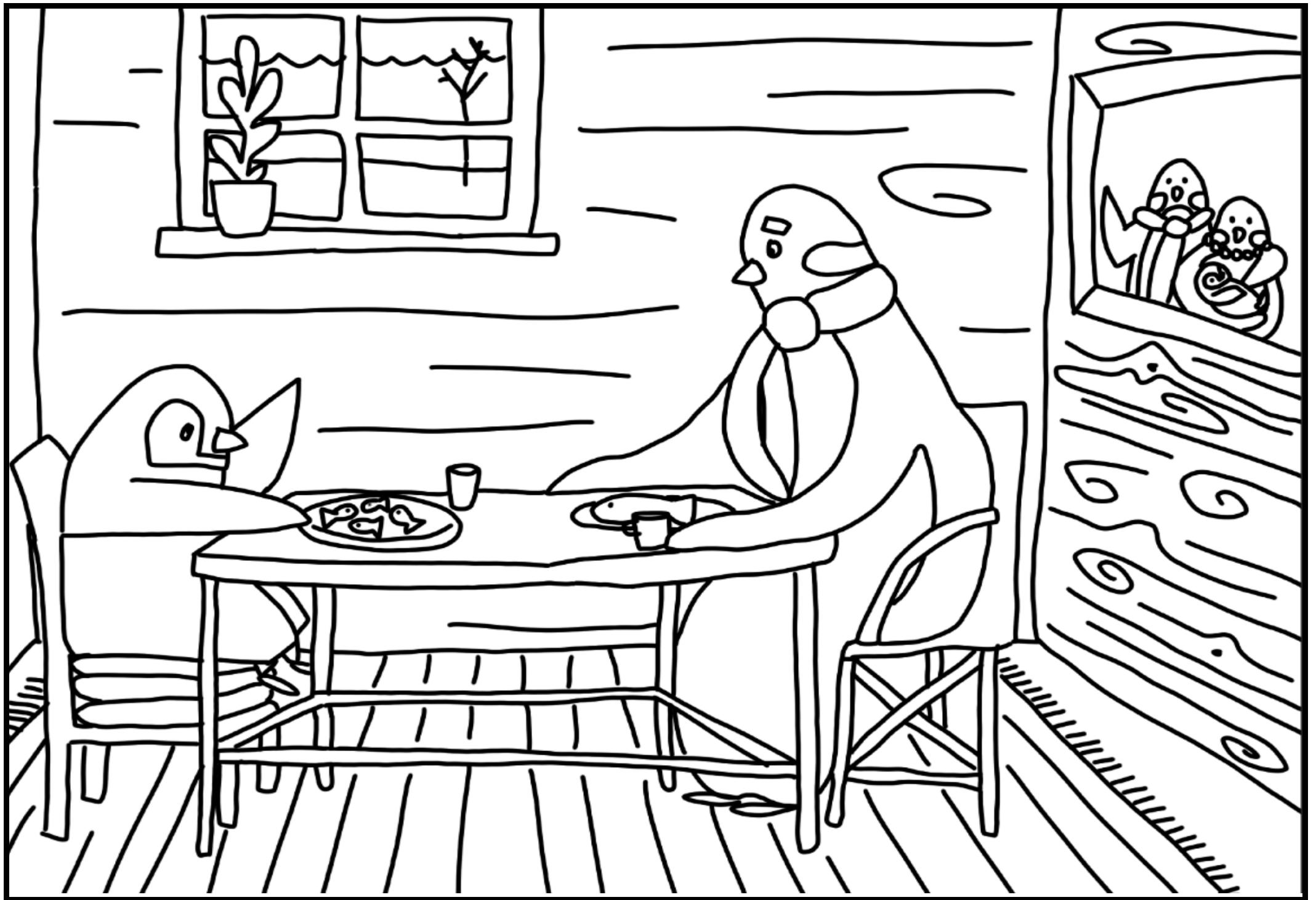
Sergio notices lots of girls screaming and shouting. What do you think they are shouting at? Pay particular attention to the shadows on the ground when colouring this image.

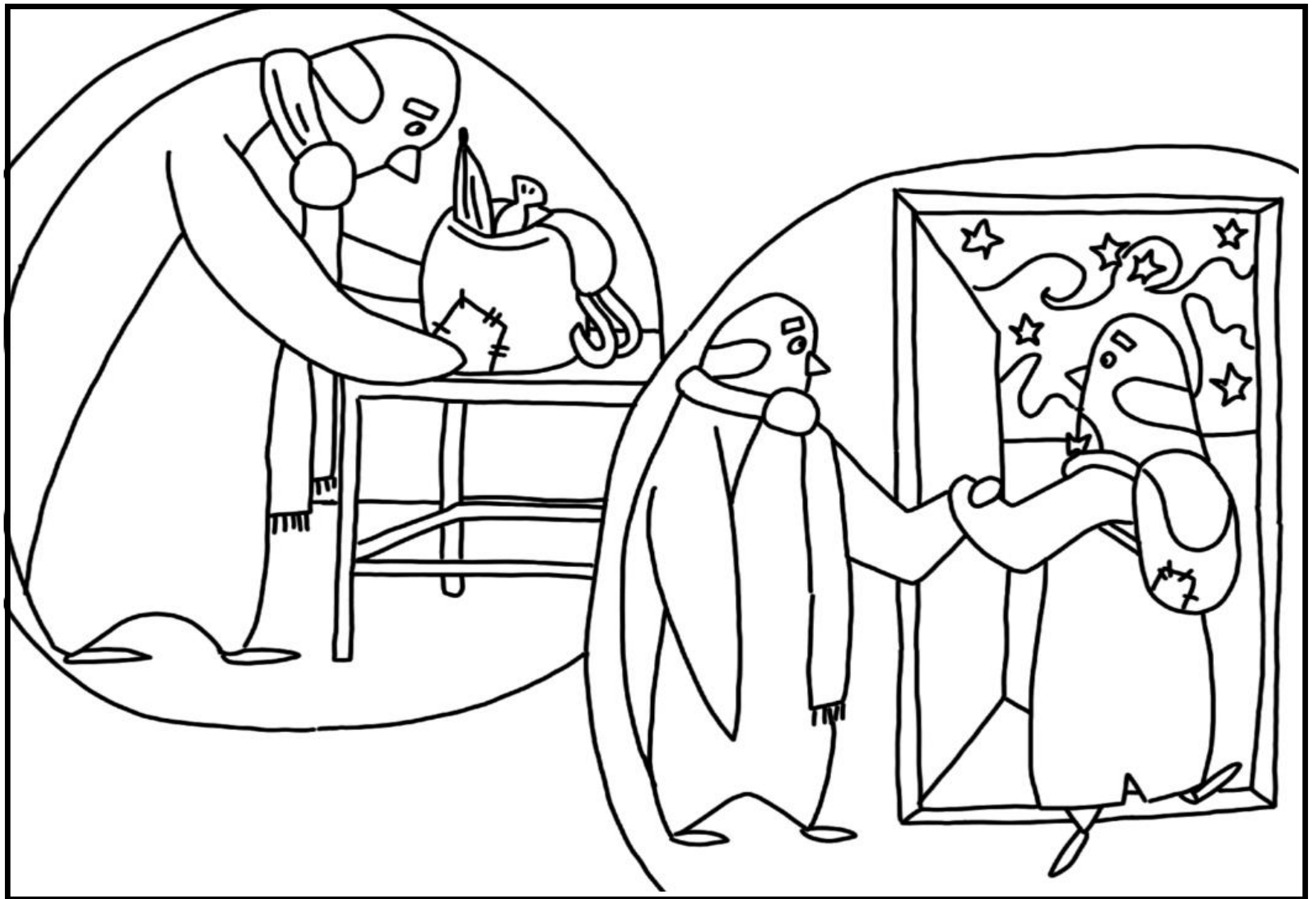

Sergio says goodbye to his father. His father prepares a back-pack for him. What is he putting inside? What do you think his father told him before he left?



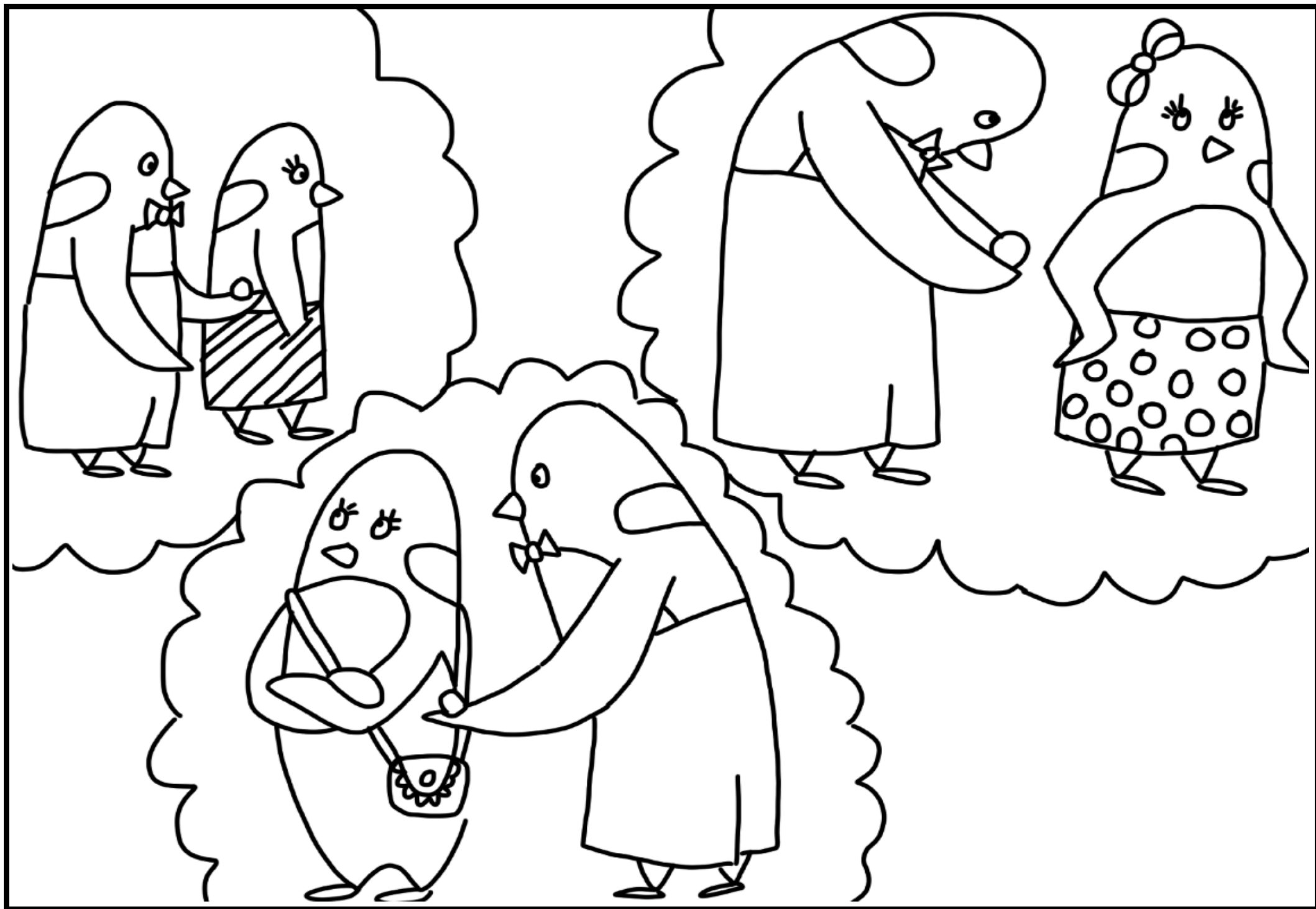

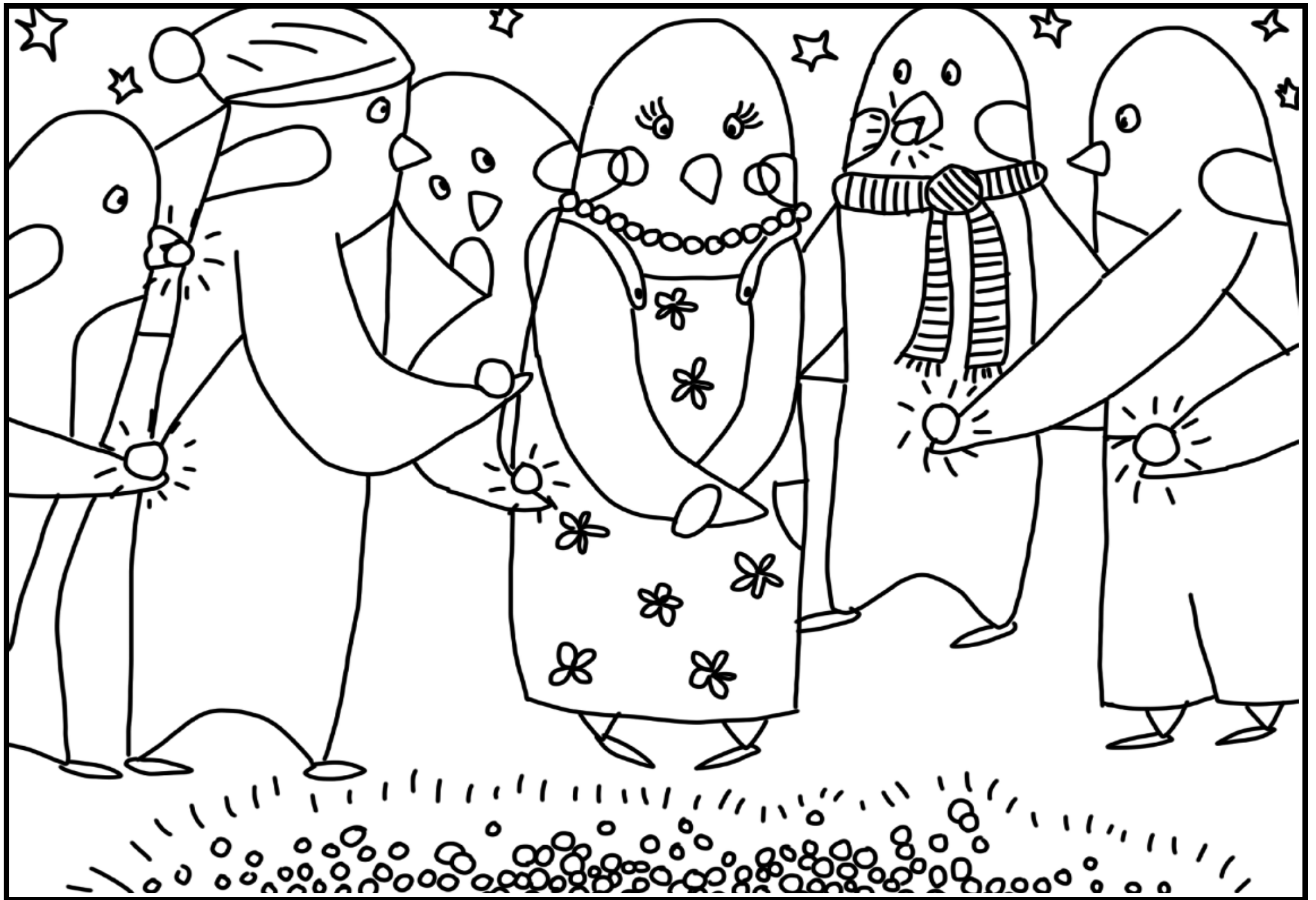

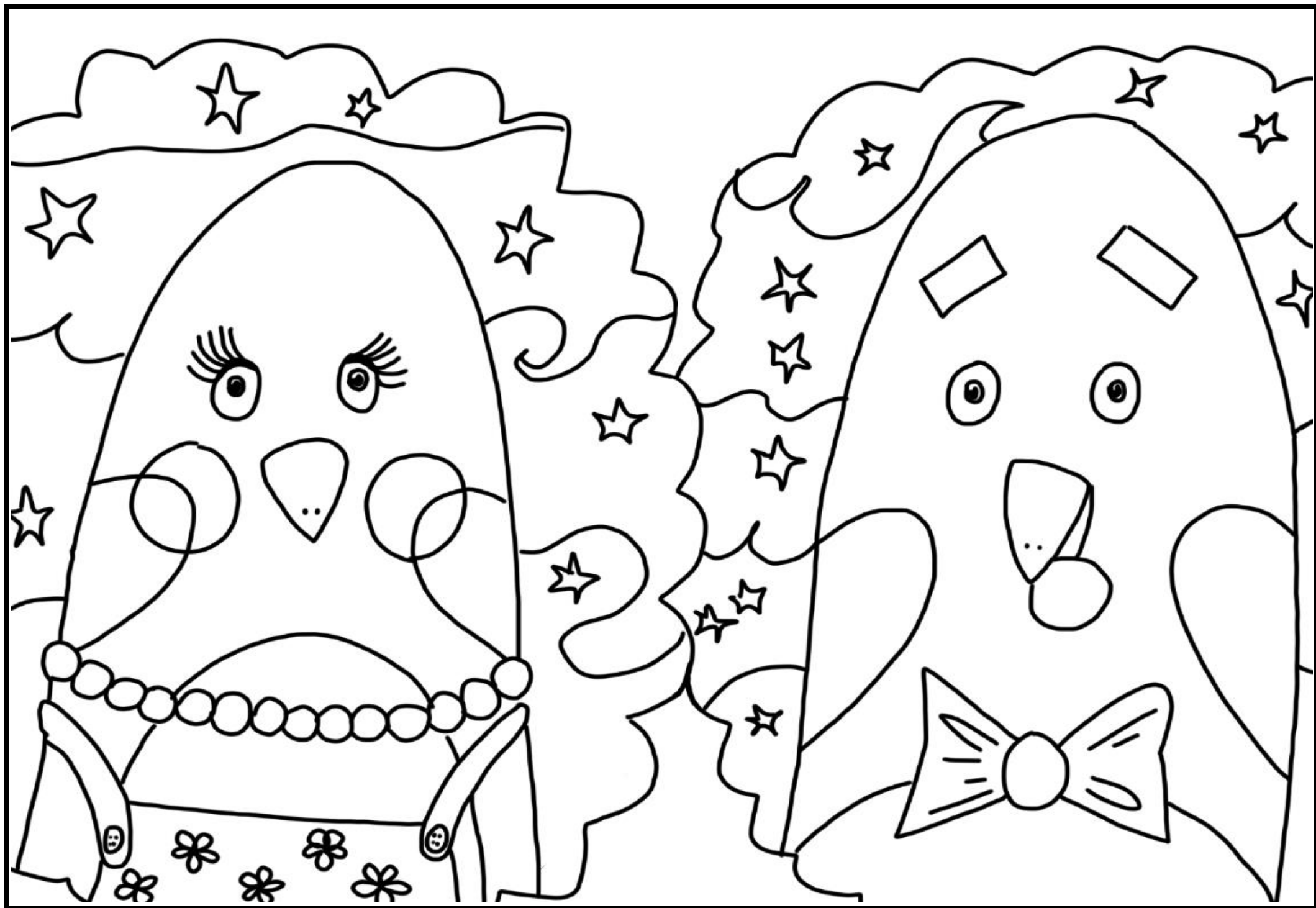
None of the girls like his piece of coal. How do you know the girls are not impressed? Try to make each girl penguin look different when colouring them in.
